Arline Catherine (Ellis) Allman died April 20 in hospice in Riverside County. She was 91.

In the week before her death from an unexpected fall, Arline bowled a 175, took two Pilates classes, and visited with friends. She was happy and active until the very end.

Born in Utah, she relocated to the West Coast in the 1940s with her father Howard Ellis; her mother Vivian (Harris Ellis); and her siblings Yvonne and Richard. In 1960 she married Jack Allman and they remained married until his death.

Arline started her business career in the “steno pool” as a teenager, and, like many women of her generation, was smarter than the men she worked for. She eventually rose to become vice-president of a real estate firm. She worked until 83 by choice and celebrated her retirement with a cruise to Alaska, where she zip-lined through the Alaskan rainforest.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband Jack; her sister Yvonne Carr; her nephew Michael Miller; her niece Becky Buehre; and too many beloved dogs to count. She is survived by her son Kevin Allman; her brother Richard Ellis and his wife Kathleen Ellis; her niece Julie Miller and her

son Justin Miller; her niece Joelle Miller and her husband Kelly Brooks; her nephew Michael Baisley and his wife Ann Baisley and their children Perrin and Porter; her dog Tramp; and far too many friends to mention here.

Arline will be interred in a private ceremony May 14 at Riverside National Cemetery. A party in Arline's honor will be held May 27 at a venue to be determined.
