



## Donald Feeley Sr

With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of Donald Feeley Sr. of Riverside, who died at the age of 85 on June 29th 2024 after the recent discovery of cancer and the progression of other age-related illnesses. Don or Senior as he was respectfully called by his family, friends and those who worked for him, was a long-time entrepreneur in the community. In 1976 he cofounded City Body and Frame under a partnership. The initial years were challenging and soon Don would find himself as the sole owner of the business. Through hard work and determination, he stayed the course and developed a thriving business. With the help of his children, devoted employees, and a fruitful partnership with his eldest son (Don Jr.), he would go on to expand the business into three thriving locations. With an ever-changing market and a generous acquisition offer, both Don Sr. and his son decided to sell the business in 2015 after 40 years of operation. Despite the sale, Don never lost his passion of working with his hands. As a lifelong learner he continued to expand his knowledge and hone new hobbies from the comfort of his home.

He was an infinitely curious man who loved to learn new concepts almost as much as he liked to teach. He was immensely proud of his children and helped foster and support all of their talents. His generosity

knew few boundaries and he found great joy in helping others. Always stopping to greet a stranger or shake someone's hand. Don continuously acknowledged and appreciated the hard work of his employees, and built strong bonds of mutual respect. In his absence we will mourn the loss of a talented and devoted father, husband, and brother, but in this despair, we will forever carry a fond light of remembrance for a man who gave so much.

Don Sr. is predeceased in death by his daughter Laura Feeley-Cruz and his brothers, Francis, Adrian, and Ken. He leaves behind his significant other of 33 years, Lori; his children, Don Jr., Mike, David, Melissa, and Leif; his siblings David and Jane; and his 5 grandchildren.
