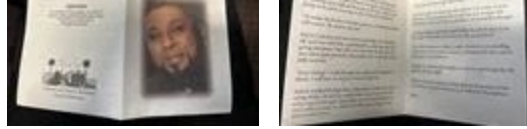
Kalvin followed in his father's footsteps and became a teacher, fulfilling his dream at a young age. He was passionate about guiding and encouraging young people, both in the classroom and on the field. As a youth soccer coach, he inspired his teams with patience, dedication, and heart, leading them to many victories while teaching lessons that went far beyond the game.

He was also a very involved member of the Dilkusha Church youth group, where his faith, leadership, and love for fellowship touched many lives.

After marrying and moving to the United States from Fiji, Calvin worked tirelessly to build a life for himself and his family in California. He began working with the Riverside County Office of Education and at Riverside Community Hospital, where he worked as a front desk employee, a public safety officer, and eventually became the night shift Public Safety Supervisor. Calvin had an incredible ability to reinvent himself and embrace new challenges. While working at RCOE, he earned his Registered Behavior Technician certification and worked with Sunny Days, supporting children in their homes with compassion and care. He later completed his Master's degree in Special Education, continuing his lifelong dedication to learning and helping others.

Outside of work, Calvin enjoyed traveling, cooking, hosting, listening to music, spending time in nature, and watching sports. He found joy in bringing people together and creating meaningful memories with family and friends.
