Linda Lamoyne Stufkosky (Morrow) born July 25, 1961, passed away surrounded by family on June 21, 2024 at the age of 62. Linda was a gifted artist and designer working as an Account Manager/Administrative Assistant at ABG Marketing, and most recently as a Manager of Client Services at QuickCaption, Inc. Linda was proud to be appointed to the Riverside City Commission of the Deaf, representing Ward 3. Linda also spent several years working in San Francisco where she became a die-hard San Francisco 49s fan.

Linda will be remembered by those who knew and loved her for her joyful and elegant dinner parties, sharing her love of wine and food, and her immeasurable generosity. Linda was at her happiest spending time with her beautiful children, partnering with Jim in their lovely garden, and bringing together her beloved friends for dinners. "Admiral Linda " cherished celebrating life on a sunset boat cruise on "Captain" Jim's boat named after Linda, Sweet Lamoyne II.
