



Ronald Hobart Holman

June 10, 1943 - February 11, 2024

Ronald Holman lived most of his life in southern California. He spent some time in Oklahoma with his parents and grandparents when he was a young boy. Ronald also spent about a year in Tucson, Arizona helping his aunt with her childcare business when he was a teenager. After high school, Ronald went to college, but that was interrupted by the Viet Nam War. Ronald enlisted in the Air Force and served in Taiwan in charge of supplies to the troops. After his service, Ronald returned to college and finished a B.A. degree in business. He then became a real estate appraiser, working for loan companies in Los Angeles. Later, Ronald moved to Riverside, California and started his own appraisal business with several appraisers working with him. In the 1980s, Ronald started working on his own as an appraiser. Ronald had also become keenly interested in politics. He became a Libertarian and served as chairman of the party for several terms of office. By the 1990s, Ronald had retired from appraising and tried other businesses. He finally became a security guard in 1995, which he continued until 2010, when he retired at age 67. When he was 80, Ronald contracted several infections which weakened his body. He finally lost the battle with sepsis and succumbed to the infections. Ronald never married or had children, but he had two long-term relationships. He is survived by two nieces and several cousins.
