Bill graduated from the University of Arkansas in 1951. He served in the US Army Intelligence Corps from 1951 to 1954 and returned to "Razorback University" for graduate studies. He was appointed a Special Agent in 1955, with Los Angeles as his first office and then served in New York for eight years. He was SRA at Greenwood, Mississippi and returned to Los Angeles in 1966. He was assigned to the Santa Ana RA and retired in 1980. He joined the Orange County Chapter of the Society and held every elected office. He later joined the Inland Desert Empire Chapter and served as chairman. He was part of the Host Committee for the 1981 Western Regional Conference in Newport Beach. He also co-chaired the Palm Springs Regional and the 1999 conference aboard the Queen Mary in Long Beach. As Western Region Vice President, he was responsible for the Northern Nevada Chapter volunteering to host the successful 2000 National Convention in Reno, NV. He was active locally with youth sports programs, the Riverside Philharmonic Society, Old Riverside Foundation and the Mt. Rubidoux Historical District.
